



Landscape Design Consultation Agreement

To help you, our valued Lawn to Garden customer, begin the process of designing a beautiful landscape for your home, a landscape that will thrive in our region’s semi-arid climate, Long Beach Water Department (LBWD) has created the “Landscape Design Consultation” program. For a nominal fee of \$50, a landscape designer will come to your home for a two-hour consultation.

The designer will not draw a design plan for you, but she or he will help you explore ideas and recommend plants and other features that may work in particular areas of your garden. Prior to your consultation complete the included worksheet, have a list of questions ready, and a basic drawing of your front yard so that you can make notes during the consultation and make sure that your questions get answered.

To participate in our Landscape Design Consultation program **you must have submitted your application for the Lawn to Garden program AND have completed the Online class found at <http://class.lblawntogarden.com>**. Please complete and sign this “Landscape Design Consultation Agreement” and mail it with your \$50.00 check (made payable to “Long Beach Water Department”) to:

Once we receive your Agreement and payment, verify that you have applied for the L2G program and completed the online training class, you will be contacted by a designer to schedule a meeting.

I, the undersigned, have read, understand and agree to the following:

I have applied for the L2G program and have satisfactorily completed the Online class (Please check box).

- I agree to waive, release, relinquish and discharge LBWD, its officials, consultants and employees from all liability, loss, claims, demands, causes of action, and damage arising out of my participation in the Landscape Design Consultation program.
- Once I am approved for the Landscape Design Consultation program, I will be contacted by a landscape designer to arrange a meeting at a mutually convenient time.
- The location of the meeting shall be the site specified below, which already has an active application in the Lawn to Garden program.
- The site is served potable water by LBWD
- The consultation will not exceed two-hours, but I may choose to end it early.
- Consultant will NOT perform any other work for me under this Agreement; any additional work performed by Consultant for me will be done at Consultant’s own expense or under a separate agreement with me, an agreement LBWD will not be a party to.
- I agree to pay in full prior to scheduling the consultation an administrative fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) made payable to the Long Beach Water Department.
